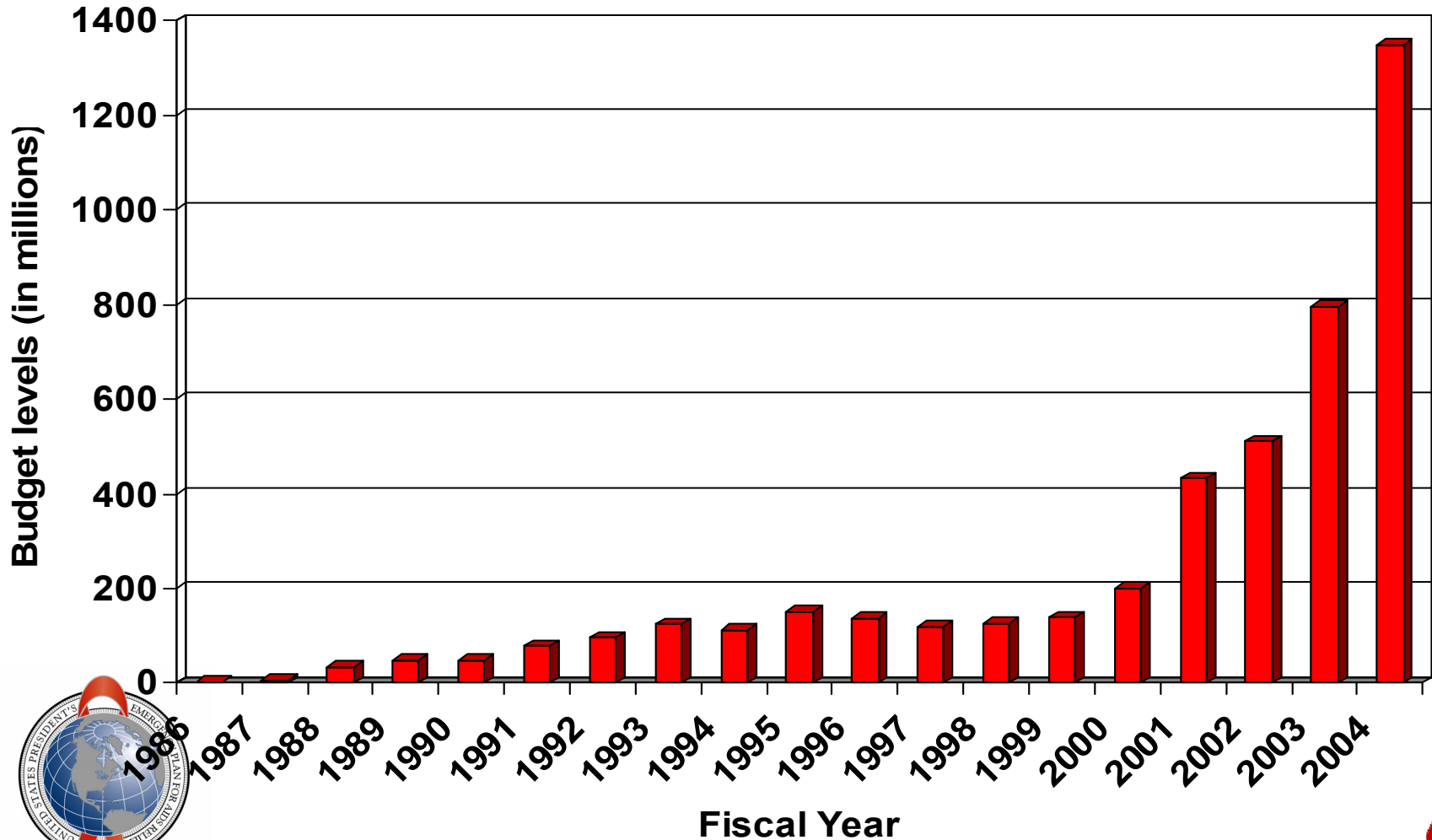


USAID Global AIDS Contribution

- Since its inception in 1986, USAID's international HIV/AIDS program has provided over \$3.2 billion in HIV/AIDS assistance.



USAID's Annual HIV/AIDS Budget



Global Health Bureau/Office of HIV/AIDS Functions:

- Technical leadership
- Field support
- Research
- International Partners: UNAIDS, Microbicides, IAVI

Global Bureau: GFATM



- Agency total for FY04, including GFATM: \$1.1 billion budget, with \$229.6 million from OGAC
- Rapid interagency programming of \$800 million in 15 countries
- OHA staff seconded to STATE, 20 providing on-going support

Public-Private Partnerships

- USAID is working with major corporations to leverage private-sector skills & expertise
- Pfizer Fellows Program sent 2 personnel in Feb 05 for six-month rotation:
 1. Support financial management of local NGO, Mothers to Mothers to Be, in South Africa
 2. Develop micro-enterprise program at Mothers Support Group in Zambia

USAID has supported the development of the Strategic Information (SI) systems for the Emergency Plan:

- Participated in design of SI Reporting Guidance
- Adoption of the DHS, AIS and SPA survey questionnaires to SI reporting standards
- Managed the development of the Country Operation Plan & Reporting (COPR) Database
- Four staff serve as SI Advisors to country programs



Operational Research

Operational research to develop and evaluate new tools to implement programs in resource-limited settings

- ARV therapy
- Prevention of mother-to-child transmission
- Increasing access to treatment and care services by people with HIV/AIDS
 - One study in Uganda increased youth VCT attendance from 66,000 to 112,000
