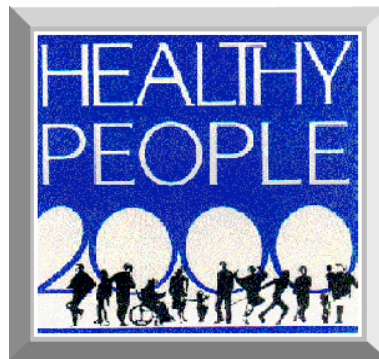

Health IT Strategic Plan: Vision and Scope

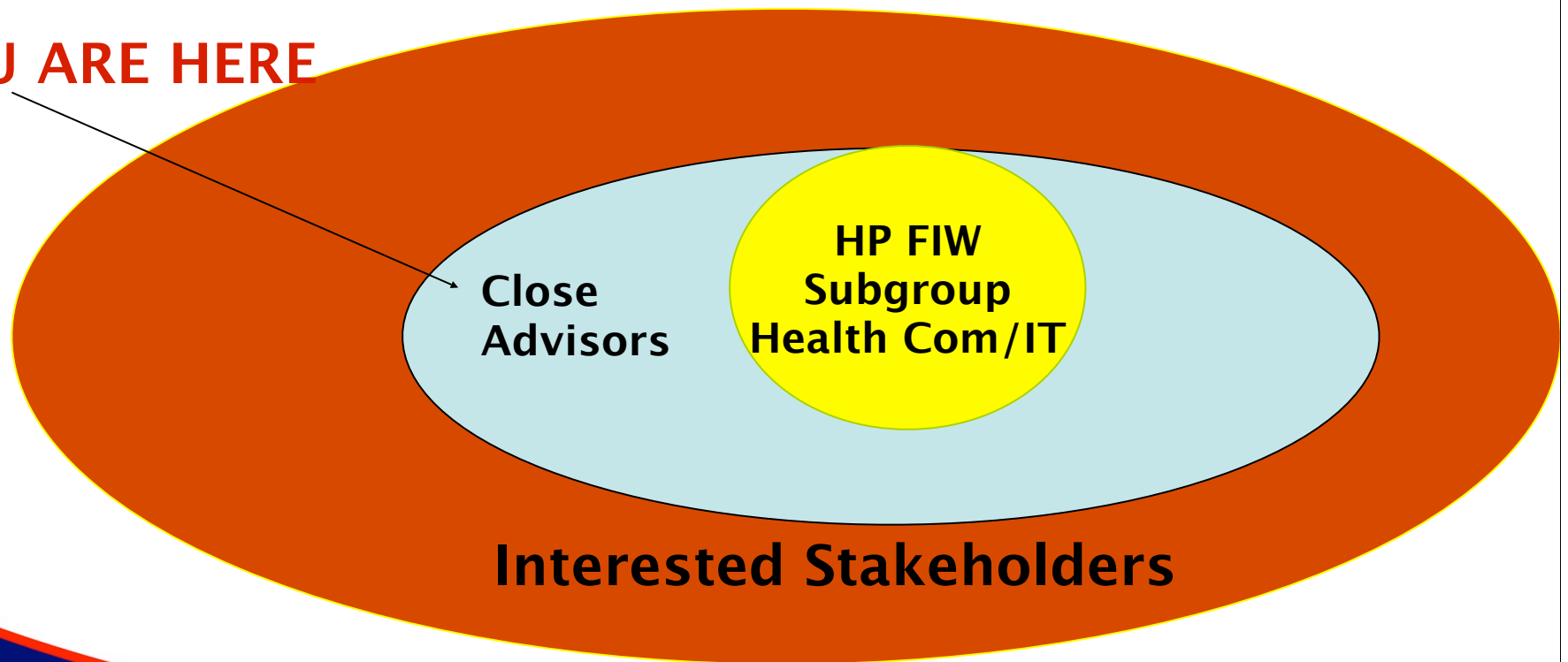
- Person-focused health care and improved population health enabled by IT
- 2012 horizon
- Describes the Federal role across multiple departments and agencies

Health IT Strategic Plan: Structure

- Two goals
- Four objectives for each goal with measurable outcomes
- 43 strategies with milestones
- Illustrative actions comprising the strategies
- Compendium of Federal activities already underway to address the eight objectives
