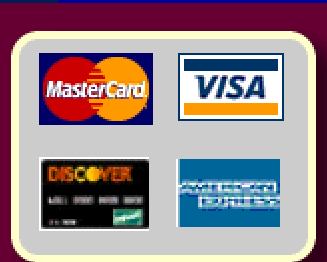
# Gaps and Barriers Identified in Current Dispensing Strategy

- Workforce - staffing requirements are high
  - High-touch activity
  - Need for volunteer training
  - Need for medical surveillance for volunteers
  - Uncertainty whether volunteers will show up during time of emergency
- Security needs
- Few models developed that look feasible
- Patient tracking/registries
- 48 hour timeframe for dispensing to population
- Lack of coordination among agencies in community
- Lack of framework to engage private sector
- Liability issues
- Leadership recognition that this is a priority

# Alternatives Ideas for Countermeasures Dispensing

- **S**ubstitute something
- **C**ombine it with something else
- **A**dapt something to it
- **M**odify or **M**agnify it
- **P**ut it to some other use
- **E**liminate something
- **R**everse or **R**earrange it
